Music Lessons – Children in Classes 4 and 5 in September 2021

If your child is interested in music and would like to learn a musical instrument, lessons are available with the teachers from the North Lincolnshire Council Music Service. Traditionally they have taught: cornet, saxophone, clarinet, flute and piano. However, if your child has a specific interest, we can find out if any teachers are available for your child.

As a guide, lessons with the Music Support Service will cost in the region of £132 per term. Your child would be expected to commit to taking lessons for a full year giving a cost of £396 based on the last price available. If your child did not wish to continue, the full year's payment must still be paid to cover the cost of the music teacher. Some instruments are available free of charge from school, but costs for any damage which occur whilst in your care, would be required.
