Dear Parents,

Risk Assessments in preparation for return to school next Monday, March 8th.

Please read carefully and inform other members of your family

Staggered entry and exit; please do not wait outside the gate area for any reason, blocking the path for other users:

- **Morning:** Please send your child to the school pedestrian-gate entrance at the following times, where a member of staff will be waiting:
 - 8.20 am: KS2 pupils (those with younger siblings may bring their brother or sister along the path)
 - 8.30 am: KSI pupils
 - 8.30 am: Nursery: any Nursery child who does not have an older sibling with whom to walk down the school pedestrian path should walk, **with one parent only**, through the side-path of the Church which leads to our side-gate in the Church car-park. Under no circumstances should parents use the Church drive as this is for a private residence. We have received permission from St Norbert's Parish Council to use the side-path, so that fewer children will be entering the school grounds at the same time.

It is very important that you are prompt – please do not come earlier and stand at the gate under

- **At the end of the day:**
 - 3 pm: Nursery to be collected from the Church side-gate
 - 3 pm: KSI to be collected from school pedestrian gate
 - 3.05pm : KS2 to leave from school pedestrian gate

The complete Return to School Risk Assessment will be sent to you on Friday, when the Governors and Trust will have made all the necessary checks, but please be reassured that your children's safety and well-being are our priorities. If you have any concerns, please email me:
