Thanks to all of you for your tremendous support over a challenging year. Let's pray that the next school year will be more settled.


On behalf of all staff, thank you so much for the lovely gifts you have sent in for us. These are much appreciated.

Government changes to contact tracing for schools

From Monday 19 July, schools, colleges and nurseries will no longer carry out routine contact tracing. From this point onwards, close contacts will be identified and contacted by NHS Test and Trace.

In response to feedback from stakeholders, we have produced guidance, some frequently asked questions and answers and a template letter for settings to send to parents, pupils and students on changes to contact tracing of close contacts.
