Parentpay

Our Parentpay system should now be up and running again for school lunch payments and for Club bookings. However, if you do experience any problems, please would you let the office know.

If you pay by a Childcare Voucher Scheme, would you please cash your vouchers in advance of making the booking. This will ensure that there are funds on your Parentpay account, to avoid your children being removed by the system from the daily registers. Thank you.

Collective Worship with Class 5

Collective Worship with Class 5 will take place on Friday 12th November (Mr Dawson's Class). Family members of children in Class 5 only are invited to attend. Would you please email the number of seats you require to admin@stnorbertscrowle.co.uk before 3pm on Wednesday 10th November.

The pedestrian gate will open for you to take your seats at 2.20pm and both Worships will begin at 2.30pm. There will be no admittance once they begin at 2.30pm or if you have not booked your seats in advance. Thank you for your co-operation.

Remembrance Day

Services of Remembrance will take place on Sunday November 14th. Ealand Cenotaph Service will begin at 10.45am and Crowle Cenotaph Service at 12, noon.

Crowle and Ealand Town Council have confirmed that there are no additional government restrictions this year, but would advise social distancing and adults' personal preference for wearing masks.

Parking/turning in the Church entrance

Please do not park or turn in the Church drive. Please inform your family too. It causes a safety hazard for our children and annoys our neighbours who have the private house.

Lollipop Crossing Patrol

Please ensure your child goes to Mr Besser to cross the road in the mornings. We will ensure your child's safety leaving the school gate at home time but each parent is responsible for

ensuring your child's safety coming to school. Please remember the staggered times. These staggered entry times at two gates have been working very well, and are much safer than our old system, if everyone remembers their responsibilities. Thanks.
