Ukraine Aid – 'Helping Hands'

This group helps refugees in the border camps and brings them to live in the Polish area Masovian district (Szydłowiec area).

If you would like to donate any of the following items, these can be brought into school and will then be collected, transported to Goole and then sent directly into the refugee camps where they are desperately needed:

- Hygiene products (tampons, pads, wet wipes, toothbrushes, toothpaste, shampoo, soap)
- Sanitizer, face masks
- Basic medicine such as paracetamol, ibuprofen, bandages
- Foods with a long shelf life such as tinned foods, rice, pasta, tea, coffee, porridge
- Baby food
- Sleeping bags and pillows
- Washing powder / liquid
- Portable power banks, flashlights etc.
