After the Celebration, refreshments and cakes will be on sale in the Activity Classroom. These can be enjoyed either in the classroom or in the school hall.

If you are able to donate a cake to be sold after the Celebration, we would be very grateful. Homemade or shop-bought cakes would be very welcome. Thank you.
