Poverty Proofing

We are proud of our longstanding efforts to ensure that no child feels excluded or marginalised due to financial constraints. However, this is and will continue to be an ongoing process. Please speak with me or your child's Class Teacher if you feel that something we do in school may result in additional financial burden for families and risk children experiencing stigma or feeling excluded.

Homework

Homework will be available from Friday 21st April for the first time this term. Please contact the Class Teacher if your child has any difficulty accessing or completing homework so that we can find a way to overcome problems together.

Homework Club will be restarting from the week beginning Monday 24th April and may offer your child an opportunity to complete all or some of the tasks expected. Please note however that some learning - such as reading and the rehearsal of times tables - is better-suited to frequent practice rather than only once each week.

Summer Uniform

Thank you for upholding our summer uniform; it was wonderful to see the children returning to school looking so smart and ready for the term ahead.
