Reminder - Foundation and KS1 Christmas Performance

Our Foundation and KS1 Christmas Performance, 'A King is Born', will take place tomorrow. Doors will open 30 minutes prior to the performance, so that you can take your seat and enjoy festive refreshments before the performance begins. Please bring your tickets for your allocated seat number. Please do not attend if you have not booked any tickets.

Should you require your baby to be with you at the performance, prams or pushchairs must be left outside and will not be allowed in the school hall. Babies are permitted to sit on your knee during our day performances only. Health and Safety requirements are such that all walkways must remain clear. The children have spent a lot of time preparing for the performance, so please do not bring babies unless absolutely necessary.

Entrance to the performance will be through the doors at the side of the hall. Ticket numbers 1 -11, 22 – 32, 43 - 53, 64 – 74, 85 – 95, 105 – 114, 124 – 133 and 142 – 150 should enter the school hall through the first door – Door 1. For any other ticket numbers, please enter through the second hall door - Door 2. Please note there will be no admittance once the performance has begun.

KS2 Christmas Performances

Tickets for next week's KS2 Christmas Performance of Ebenezer will be sent to you by the end of the week. Please note that babies and children of Reception age and below are not permitted to the evening performances. Children in Class 3 who have an older sibling may attend, but they will require their own ticket as children will not be permitted to sit on parents' knees. All After School Clubs end at the end of this week. There will be no clubs next week. Clubs will resume after Christmas.


Reminder - Foodbank
