Threadworms


There are cases of threadworms in school. Would you please keep an eye on your child for symptoms: itchy bottom and visible small white worms which look like threads in poo. Threadworms in children over the age of 2 can be treated with medicine from the pharmacy. All family members should be treated, as these can spread extremely easily.

Please encourage your child to wash hands and scrub under the fingernails, particularly before eating and after using the toilet; keep fingernails short; rinse toothbrushes before and after use and wear underwear at night.

To prevent threadworms from spreading, do not shake clothing or bedding, share towels or flannels, bite nails or suck fingers. Thank you!
