The gates for the Early Years Sports Day will open at 10am tomorrow and the event itself will start around 10.15am. If your child has an older sibling who would like to join you to watch the Early Years Sports Day, please visit the school office before 10:15am to collect. Your older child will remain your responsibility until the end of the event so do please accompany him or her back to the school office before you leave.

The gates for the afternoon Sports Day for children in Classes 3, 4 and 5 will open at 12.30pm with the event starting at 1pm. If your child has a younger sibling who would like to join you to watch Sports Day, please visit the school office before 1pm to collect. Your younger child will remain your responsibility until the end of the event so do please accompany him or her back to the school office before you leave.

All children must have a sunhat and water bottle with them, please. In the event of rain, a text message will be sent to your child's main contact by lunchtime to confirm if the Sports Day is **not** going ahead. Fingers crossed it will remain dry!
