### **Bumped Head Wristbands**

From Monday 25<sup>th</sup> September, we will be making a slight change to our procedures when responding to a 'bumped head' injury. Having found that our current 'bumped head' stickers sometimes fall off clothing, we will now provide your child with a red wristband should he or she be unfortunate enough to need one.

The purpose of the wristband is to remind you that your child has received a head injury so that you can continue to monitor him/her for signs of concussion. You will already have been notified by telephone before the end of the school day.

#### **Class Collective Worship**

You may have noticed that there is no date in the Homework Diaries for a class-led collective worship this term, with the exception of Class 5 on Friday 10<sup>th</sup> November (Remembrance). This decision has been made collectively by our staff team. During the Advent Term we will be focusing on our planned whole-school Harvest Celebration (Friday 20<sup>th</sup> October) and our Christmas Performances. Collective worship will continue in school for children as normal.

Our curriculum is deliberately sequenced and even more rigorous than previously. As a result, we must consider how knowledge is introduced and when it is then revisited, which is key to pupils knowing more and remembering more over time. Balancing this intention, alongside our collective worship schedule, has been a priority for us. Thank you in advance for your understanding.

## **Harvest Celebration**

We would like to invite you to join children from the Reception (Class 2) and Classes 3, 4 and 5, who will be celebrating Harvest together on Friday 20<sup>th</sup> October. Doors will open at 9am for a 9.30am start. Entrance will be through the doors at the side of the school hall. Due to the limited space and a high volume of ticket requests over previous years, tickets must be limited to 2 per family - in the first instance - and will be issued on a 'first-come, first-served' basis.
