Wraparound Care

Many of you will make use of our wraparound provision, which includes our Breakfast Club and Goldstar out-of-school Club. We are proud to make this offer and have done so for a considerable number of years now. As such, I would like to provide some clarity for existing users and for those who may wish to make use of these services.

Breakfast Club

Breakfast Club operates from 7:45am until school begins at 8:30am. Here, children can enjoy fun activities and games. The fee is £2.20 per child for each 45-minute session, including breakfast food and drink.

Bookings can be made through Parentpay. Please do ask the school office staff for help if you would like to make a booking for the first time.

Goldstar Out-of-School Club

Our Goldstar Out-of-School Club is run by our staff between 3pm and 6pm every day during term time. The children enjoy a full range of activities, including arts, crafts, sports and games. An evening snack is available at around 4:30pm. The cost of each session is £10.20 for the first child per evening (£8.20 per subsequent child).

All enquiries should be directed to the School Office with bookings again being made through Parentpay. The cost of making a booking must be paid before the service is used.

When using Goldstar, please contact the team on 07754 107294 (3pm-6pm during the school term) to inform staff that you have arrived to collect your child, or to pass on a message – if necessary – during club hours.
