As always, our Goldstar Out of School Club will not be open on the last day of term, Friday 19th July. All children should be collected on this day at 3pm, please. Breakfast Club will be open as usual.

Children Moving from Year 2 to Year 3

Children moving from Year 2 to Year 3 will no longer be eligible for Universal Free School Meals and any meals should be paid through Parentpay from September.

Your child may be entitled to Free School Meals. If you think you may qualify or just want to check, please apply online through North Lincolnshire Council.

Parentpay

Please do check your Parentpay account(s) and clear any outstanding balances, if applicable. All bookings for wraparound care and lunches should be paid in advance. Thank you.

Reminder - Absence from School

To ensure that our safeguarding and absence procedures are robust, we will not accept emails as a method of reporting your child's sickness absence. Please contact the school office as early as possible (but certainly before 9am) – by telephone – and speak to a member of the office staff. An absence line answerphone is available for out-of-office-hours messages.

If we only receive an email from you, and you do not telephone or visit to confirm your child's absence, this will subsequently show on your child's records as unauthorised. Our office staff will attempt to contact you after 9am, unless they have received a telephone call, until they have spoken to you. Home visits may then be necessary if we feel and the Education Inclusion Officers consulted where no contact has been possible.

If your child normally walks to school on his/her own, please telephone as early as possible if you need to report an absence so that we can ensure that he/she is accounted for and safe.

I would like to politely remind you that – in the vast majority of cases – I am unable to authorise holidays during term time; unauthorised absences must be reported to the Education Inclusion Service who may decide to issue fines as appropriate. Where both parents have joint responsibility for a child, both parents would be included in any action taken by them.

In addition, please be reminded that if you are taking your child out of school for dentist or hospital appointments, you may be asked to provide confirmation of the appointment information. Thank you for your understanding.

Proposed Visit to PGL

I am happy to confirm that we have sufficient children wishing to take part in next year's visit to PGL for this visit to go ahead.

If your child would like to attend, and you have not yet confirmed this, please email by 3pm on Monday 1st July. There are now only two places left before we reach the maximum number of children allowed to participate. The last two places will be allocated on a 'first-come, first-served' basis and telephone responses will not be accepted.

Any requests after 3pm, on Monday when the cost of the visit has been confirmed, must unfortunately be declined. Based on the number of children who have expressed interest to date, the cost would be £325 per child, inclusive of bedding.
