Harvest Celebration Tickets - Children from Reception (Class 2) onwards

Thank you to everyone who has already ordered their tickets for our Harvest Celebration taking place on Friday 18th October. We are very much looking forward to sharing this time with you.

If you have not yet done so and would like to attend, could you please order your tickets by 8:30am, this Wednesday. After this time, we will begin to allocate seats on a first-come, first-served basis and there will then be a short delay before I can tell you if there will be any further tickets available. Please wait for an update before emailing or telephoning to ask for more tickets. Thank you.

Please note that ticket allocations must be by family and not by child – i.e. if you have two children in school, please do not order four tickets. Please also note that children and babies are not permitted to sit on adults' knees as they must be included in the overall headcount; if you wish to bring them to the Celebration however, you may include them in your ticket order.

The cost of a school lunch for a child in Nursery is £2.40 and the cost for a child in either Classes 4 or 5 is £2.60. Children from Classes 2 or 3 receive Universal Free School Meals and no payment is required.

If your child normally has a school lunch, this option will be automatically included on the lunch choices going out today.
