Harvest Celebration Tickets – Children from Reception (Class 2) onwards

Tickets, showing your allocated seat number for the Harvest Celebration, have been sent home with your child this afternoon. Please look out for the brown envelopes in your child's book bag. All tickets have been allocated; therefore, please do not attend the Celebration if you do not have a ticket as we have a maximum permissible headcount in the school hall. As I explained previously, children or babies will not be allowed to sit on parents' knees, unless they have been included in your ticket order, e.g. two tickets – one adult and one child.

Doors will open for the Celebration at 1.30pm so that you can take your seats and enjoy the refreshments provided by our PTA, should you wish. The Celebration will begin at 2pm. Please note that there can be no admittance after 2pm once the Celebration has begun. Thank you.

The Collection Boxes for the Foodbank will open from Monday 14th October. If you wish to donate any items for our local Foodbank, they inform us that the following is urgently required:

UHT long-life milk, cereals, pasta sauces, tinned potatoes, tinned vegetables, tinned meats, rice pudding, tinned fruit, instant coffee (small jars), packets or tins of custard

Trainers for PE lessons and school sports

Please do not go out to buy replacement shoes if your child's plimsolls are in good condition; you now simply have the option to search for PE shoes from a wider range than perhaps before — when you are ready or when your child's PE shoes next need to be replaced. Children wearing lace-up trainers must be able to tie their own shoelaces; plimsolls remain the preferred option until they reach this developmental milestone.

Do please remember that it remains our mission to 'poverty-proof' our school day. Why? Because there can be huge pressure on children and families to 'keep up' or follow the latest fashion; we always endeavour to promote the least expensive possible option so that this burden is kept to a minimum or eliminated altogether.
