Harvest Celebration – Friday 18th October

Thank you so much to everyone who has already supported our collection for the Foodbank which opened this week; I am sure that your help will be really appreciated. The collection will remain open until after the Harvest Celebration on Friday and the items will then be sent to our local Foodbank. If you would still like to donate any items, we are informed that the following is urgently required:

UHT long-life milk, cereals, pasta sauces, tinned potatoes, tinned vegetables, tinned meats, rice pudding, tinned fruit, instant coffee (small jars), packets or tins of custard

If you would prefer to make a cash donation, a collection bucket will also be available in school on Friday afternoon.

Please do remember that there is no expectation regarding donations; we are simply making the option *to* donate a possibility for you.

The Harvest Celebration will begin at 2pm on Friday afternoon. Doors will open at 1.30pm for you to take your seat and enjoy refreshments provided by our PTA. Please note that your ticket number is also your seat number as all seats are allocated. Please enter the hall through either of the doors on the side of the hall.

We are trialling a new way of numbering the seats in the hall; please note that the seat numbers will now be on the back of your chair and not on the front. Our office staff will be available in the hall to help you to find your seat.

Please do not come to the Celebration if you do not have a ticket; the maximum number of tickets available have been allocated and we have a maximum permissible headcount. There will be no admittance to the Celebration once it has begun at 2pm.

Thank you for supporting both our Harvest Celebration and for showing solidarity with our local Foodbank – one of the principles of Catholic Social Teaching.
