Parents' Appointments

Appointment times have now been sent out with your child and appointments have been allocated to all parents. Absences - Reminders

If your child is unwell and is unable to attend school, please contact the school office before 9am on the first day of the absence to confirm that they will not be in school and to share the reason for the absence. An answerphone is available for you to leave a message before the office opens at 8am if required.

Please keep in touch with the office throughout your child's illness and after any medical appointments. From a Public Health perspective, we have a responsibility to monitor sickness absence so that we can communicate any significant information to our community (i.e. in the case of recent instances of 'slapped cheek syndrome'). However, our primary concern and duty is to safeguarding children.

If office staff are unable to contact you on either the first day of absence, or at other times where you have confirmed that you will contact us, we must follow our absence procedures and it may be necessary to visit your home address to ensure that your child is safe. All of this is necessary so that we fulfil our statutory duty; I must thank you for your cooperation and, again, your understanding.
