## Christmas Performance Tickets Class 1 (Nursery), Class 2 (Reception) and Class 3 (Years 1 and 2)

Christmas Performance tickets for the infants' performance of 'The Big Little Nativity' have been sent home with your child tonight; please do look out for the brown envelope in his/her book bag. If you do not need all of the tickets you have ordered, these should be returned to the school office as soon as you can so that they can be distributed elsewhere. Please discuss any changes you wish to make to your tickets with the office as soon as possible; your ticket should also be brought to the performances, as this shows your allocated seat number.

#### As a reminder:

The morning performance will start at 9.45am with doors opening at 9.15am for you to take your allocated seat. The afternoon performance will start at 1.45pm with doors opening at 1.15pm.

Please note that pushchairs, prams, cots, tripods etc are not allowed in the school hall and there will be no admittance, as usual, once the performance has begun.

Filming is permitted from the back row only of the hall but you will not be allowed to stand – or video – from elsewhere, as this restricts the children's view of school staff providing direction. It also affects other visitors' enjoyment of the performance. Flash photography is not permitted because it is distracting when children have worked so hard to learn their parts.

I must ask you – please – not to share photographs or videos containing other people's children on social media. Understandably, some parents may not consent to images of their children being shared online and I would encourage our community to respect this decision.

Refreshments for both performances will be available as soon as the doors are open; the Friends of St Norbert's will also have an optional raffle in the school hall, should you wish to purchase tickets. All donations are very much appreciated and support the cost of costumes and materials for our performances.

## **Advent Mass**

Our Advent end-of-term Mass will take place on Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> December at 10.30am. All friends and families are very welcome to join us in church and it would be a real pleasure to see you there if you have time. Please do consider sending your child with a small amount of change for the collection if you are able to.







#### **Christmas Parties**

The Christmas Party for the children in Class 1 (Nursery), Class 2 (Reception) and Class 3 takes place during the afternoon of Monday 16<sup>th</sup> December. Children in Classes 4 and 5 will have their Christmas Party during the afternoon of Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> December.

On the morning of the parties, children should arrive in school uniform as usual but they are invited to bring party clothes with them to change into in the afternoon.

If your Nursery child does not attend Nursery on a Monday, they are also invited to the Nursery Christmas Party. Please bring your child to the Nursery gate at 12 midday already dressed in their party clothes. Please email the school office to confirm whether he/she will be attending. Thank you.

#### **Christmas Lunch**

The form to order your child's School Christmas Lunch was sent out yesterday. If your child normally has a packed lunch, but would like a Christmas Lunch on Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup> December, please complete the form as follows:

Children who usually have a school lunch should complete the order form with their usual choices.

As a reminder, if your child would not usually be in Nursery on Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup>, and he/she would like to join us to have a Christmas lunch, do please email to confirm that they will be attending. He/she should arrive at 12 noon and should then be collected at 3pm. Please also complete the meal order form and pay for the additional lunch through Parentpay, as above.
