Reminder - May Procession - Wednesday 7th May at 11.15am and Summer Picnic

Weather permitting, our annual May Procession – in honour of Our Lady – will take place on the school field at 11.15am after the Parish Mass. As is the case every year, we would be very grateful if your child could bring a flower for the procession, as these are laid at the altar and then used in Saint Norbert's Church afterwards. However, please do not feel obliged to spend any money.

If you would like to join us, please do meet us on the school playground just before 11.15am and then follow the children onto the field or as directed. Thank you and we look forward to seeing you there if you are available.

Once the Procession has finished, children will then – again weather permitting – enjoy a 'Summer Picnic' lunch out on the school field. Those who normally have a school lunch will have a sandwich choice on the school meals link sent out for that week; those who have a packed lunch will eat their own packed lunch as usual but on the school field with everyone else.

If your child has a school lunch but you have not made a sandwich choice for this day, the choice will be made by your child in school.

Swimming for Children in Class 4 Only

Swimming lessons at the Axholme North Leisure Centre will start from Monday 12th May. All children should bring their swimming kit and towel into school each Monday morning. Children will also need a waterproof coat with them, whatever the weather, as they will be walking to and from the leisure centre each Monday afternoon. Thank you.

Year 5 Bikeability

Safe cycling lessons for the children in Year 5 take place on Monday 12th and Tuesday 13th May. Please bring your child's cycle and cycle helmet into school at 8.20am. Cycles should be left on the playground near the railings when they arrive. Thank you.

Children Walking Home - Reminder

We allow children in Class 5 (Years 5 and 6) to walk home unaccompanied if there is nobody in the playground to collect them at 3pm. If you do not wish your Class 5 child to walk home on his/her own until further notice, please let the office know as soon as possible. Similarly, do please inform the office if there are to be any unexpected changes at the end of the day and we will either communicate these to your child or keep him/her safe until you arrive.

When children do walk home unaccompanied, they are advised to return to school if they have any problems and ring the buzzer on the gate to be re-admitted.

Children from Class 4 and below should always be collected at the end of the day by a responsible adult (with password if applicable). Alternative arrangements – such as going with friends' parents, for example – should be communicated to the office before 3pm.
