Please note that 'SATs' are no longer mandatory for children in Year 2. Teachers' assessments - for children in all year groups - will be shared in your child's end-of-year Report, published before the end of term in July.

## Reminder - Swimming for Children in Class 4 Only

Swimming lessons at the Axholme North Leisure Centre will start from next Monday, 12<sup>th</sup> May. All children should bring their swimming kit and towel into school each Monday morning. Children will also need a waterproof coat with them, whatever the weather, as they will be walking to and from the leisure centre each Monday afternoon. Thank you.

## Reminder - Year 5 Bikeability

## Arbor

All parents with a registered email address with us should, by now, have received their Arbor log in details. If you have not managed to log in, could you please try to do so by the end of this week, as we would like to start sending messages through the App. Text messages will still be sent for the time being until we are confident that all parents have logged in. If you have not received an email, please check your junk folders and then please let the office staff know as soon as possible so that they can investigate. If you have received your details but have been unable to log in, please also contact the office who will be happy to help.

Please note that parents who live at separate addresses should both log in separately as you will both need to be aware of any messages and - eventually - school newsletters, that will be sent. This will be our main method of communicating with you from next term.
