Arbor

If you have not been able to access the Arbor app, or have not been receiving notifications from us, please could you let the office know as a matter of urgency. All communications will be sent through Arbor from the beginning of September.

Payments for all items should also be made through Arbor from September; this will include payments for school lunches, book bags, PE bags, hats, water bottles and school visits. Please do not make any further payments through Parentpay after the end of this week.

In addition, bookings for the Breakfast Club and Goldstar Out-of-School Club will also move to Arbor from the start of next term. To minimise the likelihood of teething troubles, and if you are planning to book your child into either of these clubs during the first week back (i.e. Wednesday 3rd, Thursday 4th or Friday 5th September), could I please ask you to email admin@stnorbertscrowle.co.uk to confirm which days you have booked – in addition to booking and paying through Arbor. Our hope is that this will help to avoid any confusion during the first week. Thank you.







Please could you arrange to check your Parentpay balance and ensure that any monies outstanding by the end of this week have been cleared. Any balances will be transferred to Arbor during the holidays. Thank you.

Uniform

As always, I would like to thank you for continuing to support our long tradition of simple and smart uniform, which is explained to all families upon accepting a place at Saint Norbert's. Our primary aim is to enable children to focus on learning, rather than becoming preoccupied with appearances in school. If any part of our uniform proves inaccessible for you, perhaps through cost for example, please do contact me - in confidence - and I will try to find a way to support.

If you are planning on having your child's ears pierced, please consider doing this at the beginning of the summer holidays to allow time for healing and avoid the need for protective plasters. Jewellery - including any type of earrings - is not allowed in school. Severe hairstyles, such as shaved patterns or coloured hair, are also not permitted.

I do hope that the weather will remain pleasant for some time; as such, children may return in September in either their summer or winter uniform until October half-term.
