Harvest Celebration – Friday 24th October

Tickets for the Harvest Celebration have been sent home with your child tonight; please do look out for the brown envelope in his/her book bag. Your seat number is shown on your ticket and this should be brought to the Celebration, as this shows your allocated seat number. If you have not ordered any tickets, please do not attend as our school hall has a maximum capacity to comply with Fire Regulations and a seat will not be available; you will not be permitted to stand at the back of the hall. Also, please do not bring small babies or children to the Celebration unless they have been included in the two tickets you have ordered as they must be included in the maximum number allowed in the hall. If you are unable to attend, please do return your tickets to the school office so that these can be allocated to a family who may not have received any on a 'first-come, first-served basis. Thank you.

Doors will open at 1.30pm for a 2pm start; our PTA will be serving refreshments from 1.30pm. As with all our Celebrations, there can be no admittance once the Celebration has started at 2pm.

I must ask you – please – not to share photographs or videos containing other people's children on social media. Understandably, some parents may not consent to images of their children being shared online and I would encourage our community to respect this decision.
