The Anxiety Workshop, offered by 'With Me in Mind', has been postponed for the time being as no places were requested. I am happy to reschedule this if any parents would have liked to attend but were unable because of the time. Do please let me know if this would help you.

Similarly, there have been no requests for places in the E-Safety workshop offered for today. Mr Pinto of the 'E-Safety Office' will, however, make a recording available which will be sent out to you at a later date.

The 'Supporting your Child to Attend School' Workshop on Wednesday 25th February *is* still available. This will run from 3 - 4:30pm (approximately) in school and is for parents only. This is an interactive workshop focusing on ways to support children who *may* experience emotionally-based school avoidance from time to time.
