Workshops offered by the North Lincolnshire 'With Me in Mind' Service and the E -Safety Office

If you would like to attend the Worry Monster Workshop taking place this Thursday, there are still places available. Please book your place as soon as you can using the link on my previous letter. 'With Me in Mind' are also running an Anxiety Workshop on Tuesday 10th February for parents only from 6 - 7:30pm.

The 'E-Safety Office' are running an E-Safety Workshop on Wednesday 11th February at 8:30am.

All of these Workshops are free and for the benefit of parents and children. Please do try to attend if you can and if you feel it may benefit your child.

'With Me in Mind' are providing *another* free workshop on Wednesday 25th February – 'Supporting your Child to Attend School'. This will run from 3 - 4:30pm (approximately) in school and is for parents only. This is again an interactive workshop focusing on ways to support children who may experience emotionally-based school avoidance. I can offer limited free places in our Goldstar Out of School Club for this time/date should you wish to attend but are unable to find alternative childcare.

Examples for this section can include: White British, White European, Black Caribbean, Mixed Background, etc. If you can add your child's country of birth and national identity, this would also be appreciated. This information is collated on behalf of the Department for Education. Examples for country of birth could be: United Kingdom, Ireland etc and, for national identity, could be English, Scottish etc. Thank you so much for your co-operation.
