Read Write Inc Workshop: Parents of Children in Class 2 (Reception) and Class 3 (Year 1/2)

We would very much like to invite parents and carers to join us for a Phonics Workshop here in school, at 3pm on Tuesday 22nd September, where we will explain how we teach children to read using Read Write Inc. Phonics.

During the session, we will talk you through some of the approaches and language your child will encounter in school, including Speed Sounds, Fred Talk and blending. We will also explain how our reading books are carefully matched to the sounds children know and, importantly, share some simple and practical ways in which you can support your child's reading at home.

There will, of course, be plenty of opportunity to ask questions and to find out more about how we can work together to help children become happy, confident readers.

Please don't worry if phonics feels unfamiliar or rather complicated! You certainly don't need to be a phonics expert. Just a few minutes of positive practice each day, alongside enjoying and sharing stories together, can make a very real difference to your child's confidence and progress.
